


## Marine Safety Information Bulletin 24-25

Arroyo Colorado River Closure Issue Date: April 1, 2025

Due to recent surveys conducted by the U.S. Coast Guard and Army Corps of Engineers, the U.S. Coast Guard Captain of the Port (COTP) Corpus Christi has deemed the Arroyo Colorodo River unsafe for navigation by all mariners and is closing the waterway. No vessel may enter, transit, or remain within the Arroyo Colorado River until such time as water level recedes, current speed reduces, critical aids to navigation are corrected, and the COTP deems it safe.
